Ms. Philibotte has been a member of the English & Performing Arts Department at Goffstown High School since 2008. She is a two-time National Writing Project Fellow and continues to serve on the NWPNH Leadership Committee. In 2012, Tina created and implemented a curriculum for dance at Goffstown High School where dance can now be taken for fine arts credit during the school day. She founded and directs the GHS Movement and Dance Company, one of very few concert dance programs in New Hampshire public schools. Since 2008, Tina has been the resident choreographer/co-director for GHS Performing Arts musical theatre including productions of "Phantom of the Opera," "The 25th Annual Putnam County Spelling Bee," and "Spamalot." She has choreographed and performed throughout New England as a founding member of Terminal Hip Dance Theatre (THDT) since 2002 and with the Ninth State Dance Company. Tina has taught Master Classes and choreographed for several New England schools including Wellesley College (MA), St. Andrew's School (RI), Plymouth State University, New Hampton School, and the Holderness School. Tina is on the executive board of the New Hampshire Dance Alliance. She is also a member of the National Dance Educator's Organization and a presenter at the 2016 National Conference in Washington, DC. She lives in Concord, NH with her husband, daughter, and two cats.
